THE DURHAM MUSEUM: (www.durhammuseum.org) Located at 801 South 10th St. – (0.2 mi. 5 min. walk)

Making its home in one of Omaha's most unique treasures, Union Station, The Durham Museum offers a fascinating look at the history of our region and offers a broad-range of traveling exhibits covering subjects ranging from history and culture, to science, industry and more through our affiliation with the Smithsonian Institution and strong ties with the Library of Congress, National Archives and the Field Museum.

JOSLYN ART MUSEUM: (joslyn.org) Located 1.4 miles (6 min) at 2200 Dodge St.

The Joslyn Art Museum is the principal fine arts museum in Nebraska. It has a comprehensive permanent collection, and although it includes works from [Paolo Veronese](#), [El Greco](#), [Titian](#), among others, its greatest strengths are the outstanding art collections of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries of [American](#) and [European artists](#) such as [Pierre-Auguste Renoir](#) and [William-Adolphe Bouguereau](#).

GENERAL CROOK HOUSE MUSEUM: ([click](#)) Located 5.3 miles (11 min) at 5730 N 30th St, Bldg 11B .

--- The Museum is the authentically restored home of Civil War and National Indian Wars hero, General George Crook, and is on the National Register of Historic Places. Celebrating 140 years in 2019, it was constructed in 1879 while General Crook served as the Commander of the Department of the Platte. General Crook is known for his supporting role in the landmark 1879 trial of Standing Bear v. Crook. The house was built in the Italianate style, which represented the grandeur of the military frontier. All furnishings are antiques from the 1880 Victorian period.
