**BOYS TOWN:** ([www.boystown.org](http://www.boystown.org)) Located at 137<sup>th</sup> and Dodge Street – ( 25 minute drive )

---When Father Edward J. Flanagan purchased the Overlook Farm in 1921, it became the new, permanent site of Boys Town. Over the decades that followed, schools, churches and homes were built, and tens of thousands of young lives have been transformed. When you visit the Village of Boys Town, you'll get an unforgettable glimpse into the history of an organization that has given new hope to so many at-risk children over the past 100 years.

**HENRY DOORLY ZOO:** Located 2.8 miles (9 min) south of the hotel at 3701 S. 10<sup>th</sup> St.

---Omaha is a cool place to be for a whole host of reasons, not the least of which is its zoo, which is consistently rated the number one paid attraction in the whole state of Nebraska. It's not hard to see why: the [Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium](#) is home to 17,000 animals representing 962 species, and it also boasts the Desert Dome — the world's largest indoor desert, which is housed under the world's largest geodesic dome. As if it didn't already have enough superlatives, the Doorly is also home to the largest indoor swamp, which is known by the mysterious moniker of the Kingdom of the Night. And its attached aquarium is the largest within a zoo in the country, offering you the chance to wander through exhibits featuring everything from temperate ocean life and coral reefs to Antarctic penguins and polar bears.

At 170 acres, the Doorly is big enough that you might want to take advantage of the trams that shuttle visitors around between Memorial Day and Labor Day, or hop on board the Omaha Zoo Railroad.
