\$324 for a king or two queens, but that includes breakfast, free snacks and beverages in your room or in the club area, wi-fi, bikes, a roof top bar (for our reception weather permitting) or a club-mezzanine area, and a bar/eating area on the first floor. The Loutrel is in the historic area, next to the "market area," and within a 6 square block area of it, there must be over 100 restaurants and bars. You will like it.

The hotel will take a card number but not charge it until you arrive. 48 hour cancellation policy. For those driving, there is parking for a fee, and for those flying, the airport is about 15 miles away—a 25-30 minute van ride into town. We have Uber and Lyft in the area, and they do the airport. There is a fleet of mini vans hanging around the airport that will take you into town as well. Their fares are reasonable. There are also taxis (the most expensive). When coming out of the terminal baggage pick-up area, directly across the street you will see taxi stands, places to meet Uber/Lyft cars, and the mini vans.
